1. The example

The public hospital in 7350 Oberpullendorf, Pannonia.

The hospital was opened in 1929 and modernized and expanded until today. The main focus lies on the medical care for the people of the middle of Pannonia state. Approximately 20.000 out- and 13.000 in patients are been treated per year.



2. The scenery

The photorealistic scenery was build from scratch. GoogleEarth and pictures taken on site were used as data source. The helipad is for VFR only. In real this helipad has no ICAO code. To make it easier to find the helipad in the directory and in the GPS the fictional code 7350 (zip code) was used. Some objects are from the joint library of the AXDG and from other sources.

3. Functions (summary)

- Photorealistic scenery
- Compatible to OSM+autogen from PilotBalu
- Compatible to X-Plane 10 HD Mesh Scenery v2 from alpilotx
- Realistic ground texture on the heliport area
- Night textures and realistic lightning

4. Installation

Simply unpack the folder and copy the content into your 'custom scenery' folder of X-Plane. Restart X-Plane and enjoy.

5. Recommended settings

To visualize all light effects, HDR should be activated. The higher the settings for "texture resolution" and "airport detail" the better the quality of the scenery but the more affect on the FPS ratio.
