1. Description

In many airports manhole covers are installed for the discharge of rain water or access to utility lines on the apron. To be able to place them easier, this package contains 11 manhole covers, that can be installed as .pol on the apron easy.

2. Usage

2.1. as .pol

- Copy the desired manhole cover (the .png and the .pol-File) to the scenery-directory,
- open the scenery with WED
- select the .pol-file in WED,
- like any other .pol file place it with the mouse with 4 clicks (as square as possible).
- If necessary, adjust the position or aspect ratio with the vertex tool or the size with the Marquee Tool.

2.2. as .png

- Copy the desired manhole cover (the .png-File) to the scenery-directory,
- open the scenery with WED
- select the .png file in Wed-menu "View / Pick overlay image"
- this is now placed "full frame" in the scene
- correct the size with the Marquee tool now (holding down the "Ctrl" key with fixed aspect ratio) or the correct orientation (while holding down the "Alt" key)
- in Wed-menu select "Edit / Make Draped polygon" (only available in versions less than 1.3)
- Open the generated .pol file in the same directory where the is the .png file with a text editor and add the missing entries (as in the .pol files in this package).
